

JROTC I for PLT Grading Plans

Method that will be used to calculate students' grades each quarter:

- HW 10%
- Quizzes 5%
- Tests 15%
- Uniform and Inspection 40%
- Class Assignment/Physical Training 30%

Homework

SUGGESTIONS:

1. Late homework will be accepted and feedback will be given to students. No points will be deducted for the first two weeks. Five points will be deducted for each week late, after the first two weeks. The lowest grade for completed work will be a 60.
 - First two weeks – full credit (100%)
 - 1 week late – highest grade possible is 95
 - 2 weeks late – highest grade possible is 90
 - 3 weeks late – highest grade possible is 85
 - 4 weeks late – highest grade possible is 80
 - 8 or more weeks late – highest grade possible is 60, unless student refuses to complete the assignment
2. Homework is important practice of skills required for success in this course. It is important that students complete all homework assignments. All homework will be given full credit as long as it is turned in by the end of the quarter.

Missed Work

1. Students are expected to make up work that they missed due to absence. Tests and quizzes can be made up during lunch or before or after school.
2. Students are expected to make up missing work when they return to class. Students can access any missed material in the classroom.
3. Missing work will be accepted for credit until the next quarter. A grade deduction of 5 points per week will be applied to all work that is received after an unexcused absence or outside of the required window after excused absences.
4. To update your grade....Students must to print their grades in PowerSchool and take it to SFC Williams.
5. Uniform Wear (JROTC I) – make up uniform wear within the quarter.

Prevention-Intervention Plan

Suggestions:

1. Students who receive a test grade below a 70% will be given the opportunity to retake the test, with the highest grade possible of 85%.
2. All students can retake tests within one week of receiving their original grade.
3. Students who receive below a 70% for the 1st quarter, 2nd quarter or both will be given a Grade Recovery Contract. The Grade Recovery Contract will:
 - Serve as an intervention for any student whose quarterly average is below a 70%.
 - Allow a student's quarterly average to be changed to a 70% provided the student has fulfilled all expectations outlined in the plan and the student's next quarterly-weeks average is at least a 70%.
