SUBJECT: JROTC UNIFORM WEAR 11 August 2023

ATTN: PARENTS/STUDENTS

- Cadet Command Regulation 145-2 requires all JROTC Students to wear the JROTC uniform to school one day per week. (TUESDAYS or WEDNESDAYS, depending on JROTC class day (A day or B day)) unless changed by JROTC Instructors.
- 2. JROTC students must wear the JROTC uniform for the **ENTIRE** school day unless they are enrolled in health, physical education or other classes that require them to change clothes. If a JROTC student does have any of these classes, please allow them to change to and from the uniform at your discretion.
- 3. When wearing the dress coat the student should wear the coat with all buttons buttoned. While the student is in class they may unbutton the coat or remove the coat and hang on chair/desk. If a student should depart the classroom for any reason, they must return to the complete uniform. At no time should the student remove their dress shirt, un-tuck their shirt or remove their neck-tie/neck-tab, shoes, boots, for any reason while wearing their uniform.
- 4. Ladies/Girls uniform is slightly different from the Males/boys uniform. The girls should wear their hair at a neat appearance, pinned up so that it does not hang down past the collar of the coat or shirt (THERE ARE SOME UPDATE TO THE HAIR STANDARDS. THESE UPDATES WILL BE ADDRESSED BY THE INSTRUCTORS). Girls may wear one set of earrings and they should not be larger than 1/4inch in diameter. Girls may also wear hair-bows or attachments. The attachments and hair bows should be of good taste and should match or blend in with the color of their natural hair. At no time should the student wear bright or illuminating colors for hair attachments or nail polish. The nail polish should be a color that is matching and appropriate for the JROTC Uniform. Girls shirt tail should remain tucked inside trousers/slacks at all times. Shoes should remain on feet, laced up to the top and tied into a bow knot.
- 5. Men/Boys CANNOT wear earrings while wearing the uniform. Hair should be neatly worn, trimmed and should not exceed over the ears or present a ragged appearance. Males CANNOT wear braids, dreadlocks, beards or goatees. Males may wear a neat trimmed mustache that does not exceed over the top lip or past the corners of the mouth. Males may also wear a side burn. The side burn should not exceed past the lowest part of the outer opening of the ears. Males CANNOT wear chains, or necklaces

- on the outer part of the uniform. Male shoes will be worn on feet laced and tied up to top of shoes and tied into a bow know.
- 6. Both male and female students will wear a JROTC issued webbed black belt with gold buckle while wearing army blue slacks/trousers. Male students will wear a black necktie and female students will wear a black neck-tab with the dress Jacket or without the dress jacket when instructed to do so.
- 7. At no time will male or female slacks/trousers present a sagging appearance while wearing any of the Army JROTC uniforms.
- 8. Second period JROTC students while conducting the <u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE</u> are required to stand up, place their right hand over their heart or render a hand salute and recite the pledge.
